THAT, aware that the promotion of local tourism has been devolved under part II of the fourth schedule of the Constitution of Kenya, 2010; Further aware that section 29 of the Forest Act, 2005 provides that every local authority shall as far as reasonably practicable establish and maintain arboreta, mini-forests or recreational parks for the non-consumptive use of persons residing within its area of jurisdiction; also aware that section 45 of the Forest Act, 2005 provides for community participation in the conservation and management of state forest and local forest ; also further aware that Kipyosit Sub Location is situated along the Mau Forest belt that annually experience the arrival of large herd of elephants that graze along the belt; aware that their arrival provide an attractive scenery that fascinates the locals and school going children; also aware that this can be a source of tourist attraction both locally and internationally and in return shall be a source of revenue for the County Government as well as will help improve the living standards of the locals; this County Assembly therefore urges the County Executive Committee to establish a tourist attraction center in Kipyosit Sub location, along the Mau Forest belt within a period of two years.
