THE BOMET COUNTY COMPASSIONATE ASSISTANCE BILL 2021 THIRD READING.

Hon. J. Kirui (Majority Leader): Hon. Speaker I beg to move that The Bomet County Compassionate Assistance Bill 2021 Assembly Bill number 4 be read a Third time.

Mr. Speaker, as I had said in the morning, this bill is long overdue and I urge the hon. members that we allow this bill to go to the third reading so that we fast track it in order to be implemented by the County Executive. As I am talking now, there are some sick patients in my Ward where a vulnerable child who is in Tenwek mission hospital really needs to be assisted through this bill. I really urge hon. members that we allow this bill to be read a third time so that it's implemented. We know it will really assist the residents of Bomet. This is one of the bills which is known to be assisting a lot. Most of the residents have been asking us that they

have been told that it's the County Assembly that has delayed the passage of the bill yet it's not true and now since it's with us. Let us allow it to the Third Reading so that we are not getting rumours about the same. Otherwise, thank you for the opportunity.

Hon. J. Kirui (Majority Leader): Hon. Speaker, indeed I want to thank the members; reading the mood of the House hon. Speaker; for accepting that this bill is read for the third time because from the way hon. member from Sigor ward has said it's long overdue; it's in the public domain that this House was accused of delaying this bill but although it has been delayed we dispense with this matter so that the residents of Bomet can be able to actually enjoy the benefits of having this bill. We know there have been a lot of disasters happening and one of them happened in my ward Ndarawetta where some shops were razed down and I think it has also happened in other places. With the enactment of this bill, I believe the Controller of Budget will raise the funds so that the people of this County can enjoy the funds. Otherwise, I support and I want to urge the hon. Members that they support this bill. Thank you hon. Speaker.
