STATEMENT DUE ON 17th NOVEMBER, 2021 AT 2.30 P.M

1. Comprehensive statement sought by Hon. Ambrose Koech on 27th July, 2021 from the Chairperson **Committee on Energy, Environment, Water and Natural resources** concerning water supply and water projects within the County. The seeker wanted to be specifically informed on the following;

- I) Water projects in the county;
 - a) The list of all water projects which are currently in existence within the County
 - b) The list of all water projects which are currently managed by Bomet Water Company
 - c) Any support which has been advanced by the County Government to each water project
 - d) The number of customers/residents served by each water project
 - e) The status of all projects in terms of infrastructure including piping and pumping stations
- II) Bomet Water Company;
 - a) The number of customers who are served by the company
 - b) How many employees have been engaged by the Company?
 - c) What is the total wage bill per month?
 - d) Total amount of revenues generated by the Company annually
 - e) What is the cost of electricity incurred by the Company annually?
 - f) How much is the outstanding expenses/Bills?
 - g) Maintenance cost incurred by the company annually

2. Comprehensive statement sought by Hon. Marcella Chepkirui on 21st September, 2021 from the Chairperson Committee on Labour and Public Service concerning the County internship programme. In the statement, the chairperson should;

- I) Indicate the number of interns engaged by the County Government in the Financial years 2020/2021 and 2021/2022 respectively.
- II) Considering, the County Assembly approved budget of Kshs 9 Million in the Financial year 2020/2021 and kshs 18 Million in the Financial year 2021/2022, explain why the interns have not been paid their stipends since may, 2021.
- III) Indicate when the interns will be paid by the County Government.
