My question is to the Chairperson Committee on Agriculture, Livestock and Fisheries concerning the outbreak of rabies within Chemagel Ward in Sotik Sub-County. In the recent past, Brian Kipkoech of Kibajit Sub-Location was bitten by an infected dog and is currently undergoing treatment while Simon Langat of Kibori Village in the same Sub-Location has lost a cow due to the said disease. In his reply, the chairperson should state:

1. Whether the relevant County Executive Department is aware that cases of rabies disease outbreak have been reported in the said ward.
 2. Whether the relevant County Executive Department is aware that a child and livestock in the said ward have been affected.
 3. Whether the county government will meet the costs incurred in the treatment of the affected child.
 4. The steps that have been taken by the County Government to address the outbreak.
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
