QUESTIONS & STATEMENTS

The following are due:

1. Question asked by **Hon. Charles Langat** on 13th October, 2022 concerning the status of waste disposal in all the factories, educational institutions, hospitals and residential buildings in Bomet County. The County Executive Committee Member in charge of Lands, Urban Planning and Housing was required to:-
 - (1) Provide a comprehensive report on the status of compliance with the National Environmental Management Authority (NEMA) rules and regulations by the said facilities;
 - (2) State the steps that the department has undertaken or is planning to undertake to ensure compliance with the said rules and regulations if number one above is in the negative.
 - (3) Indicate whether the department has qualified personnel who in conjunction with NEMA would ensure compliance;
 - (4) State whether there are designated places of waste disposal in the stated facilities;
 - (5) State whether the department has received any complaints from the members of the public concerning the status of waste disposal in any of the stated facilities
