STATEMENTS DUE ON 11TH JUNE, 2019 AT 2.30 P.M

1. Statement sought by Hon. Zadock Kilel on 11th June, 2019 from the Leader of Majority concerning the running of the affairs of the County during the temporary absence of the County Governor. In the statement, the Leader of Majority should indicate;
 - i. Whether he is aware of any communication from the office of the Governor indicating that the Deputy Governor will hold brief for the County Governor and that he will be assisted by the County Secretary and Chief of Staff as circulated in the social media? If so, kindly provide a copy of the communication.
 - ii. Whether there are any power wrangles or supremacy battles as alleged in the media

2. Statement sought by Hon. Robert Rono on 9th April, 2019 from the Chairperson Committee on Infrastructure regarding the construction of following roads: -
 - (1) Kaphilemon-Sogoet primary-Ketero Primary Road in Ndanai-Abosi Ward. In the Statement, the Chairperson should indicate;
 - a) The current status of the road;
 - b) The name of the Contractor;
 - c) The contract price;
 - d) The previous works undertaken by the contractor and;
 - e) The Bill of quantities of the stated road;
 - (2) Chepkosa-Corridor Road, Chepkosa-Cheptolelyon Road and Lelaitich-Mabutek Road in Sigor Ward; In the statement, the Chairperson Should state;
 - (a) The Contract price of each of the stated roads;
 - (b) The amount of contract price that has already been paid to the contractors;
 - (c) Why there is poor installation of culverts in the stated roads;
 - (d) Why the said roads were not compacted;
 - (e) Why the roads were poorly gravelled;

 - (f) Why the said roads were not compacted;
 - (g) Why the roads were poorly gravelled.

 - b) How much money has been spent on roads repairs under the emergency fund in the financial year 2018/2019 in all the 25 wards? (Specify the road, the distance and the amount spent on each road.
 - c) How much money is left after road repairs
 - d) Which roads have been repaired using County Machinery;
 - e) Specific criteria used to allocate the machinery for road repairs and construction

 - (iv) All the Public Interest (P.I) parcels of land that have been identified and secured by the county government
