STATEMENTS DUE ON 17th MAY, 2017 AT 9.00 A.M

1. Statement sought by Hon. Hellen Chepkirui on 1st March, 2017 from the Chairperson, Labour and Public services Committee regarding the number of Persons With Disabilities who have been employed in the County Public Service since inception of the County. In the statement , the chairperson should state:-
 - a. The policy which the county government is using to ensure the progressive implementation of the principle that at least 5% of the members of the public in elective and appointive bodies are persons with disabilities
 - b. The number of persons with disabilities who have been employed in each department of the county executive including the county executive committee.
 - c. The numbers of persons with disabilities who have been employed as Early Childhood Education and Development assistants since this was a major recruitment in the County

The Statement was committed to the Committee on Labour and Public services (Statement No. 99)

2. Statement sought by Hon. Hellen Chepkirui on 1st March, 2017 from the Chairperson, Gender, Sports and Social services Committee regarding allocations of funds for Persons With Disabilities. In the statement, the Chairperson should state;
 - a. The amount of money allocated to the persons with Disabilities during the 2016/2017 Financial Year and the amount which has already been used and the purpose for which it has been utilized.
 - b. The various programs undertaken to assist persons with different disabilities i.e with severe disabilities and non-severe disabilities

3. Comprehensive statement sought by Hon. Sammy Chelule on 18th January, 2017 from the Chairperson, committee on Budget and Appropriation on the following;
 - i. It is now approaching seven (7) months since F.Y 2015/16 ended yet the County Executive Member for Finance and Controller of Budget have yet to remit Assembly's outstanding balances on development and recurrent funds committed in the F.Y. 2015/16. I therefore wish to know when the said balances will be remitted to the Assembly.
 - ii. Aware that the Governor assented to the Bomet County Appropriation Act 2016 and subsequent warrant with Assembly's development vote amounting to **Ksh.116, 408,716**. I am reliably informed that despite Assembly submitting work plan and requisition for development funds, the said funds have not been released to the Assembly. Through the Chairperson, I wish to know why the County Executive Member for Finance and Controller of Budget have not released the funds and when the said funds will be released to the Assembly.
 - iii. CEC member for Finance and representative of the Controller of Budget should urgently appear before the committee on Budget and Appropriation to address the matter.
