STATEMENTS DUE ON 24th MAY, 2017 AT 2.30 P.M

1. Comprehensive statement sought by Hon. Leonard Kirui on 30th August, 2016 from chairperson, committee on Labour and Public service on the fate of ECD assistants employed by the County Government. In particular, the chairperson should inform on the following;
 - a. Why the ECD assistants (recruited) have not received confirmation letters yet they have passed through the required employment procedures?
 - b. What is the department's plan towards the issuance of confirmation letters?

The Statement was committed to the Committee on Labour and Public service (Statement No. 70)

2. Comprehensive statement sought by Hon. Wilson Keter on 23rd November, 2016 from the chairperson committee on Gender, Culture and Social services on the Implementation of Old person's stipends and NHIF contributions schemes. In particular the Hon. Member wished to get clarification as to the reasons behind the continuous and unnecessary delays in the remittance of the NHIF contributions which has greatly affected the beneficiaries since they cannot access medication

The Statement was committed to the Committee on Gender, Culture and Social services (Statement No. 81)

3. Statement sought by Hon. Hellen Chepkirui on 1st March, 2017 from the Chairperson, Gender, Sports and Social services Committee regarding allocations of funds for Persons With Disabilities. In the statement, the Chairperson should state;
 - a. The amount of money allocated to the persons with Disabilities during the 2016/2017 Financial Year and the amount which has already been used and the purpose for which it has been utilized.
 - b. The various programs undertaken to assist persons with different disabilities *i.e* with severe disabilities and non-severe disabilities

The Statement was committed to the Committee on Gender, Sports and Social services (Statement No. 98)

4. Statement by Hon. John Ngetich on 18th January, 2017 from the Chairperson Committee on Labour and Public Service on the employment of senior directors in the County Public Service Board. In the statement, the Chairperson should indicate;
 - (a) Which job group is the designation of "senior director" falls into?
 - (b) Whether there is any staff establishment which indicates the position of a senior director and if there is any who approved the establishment?
 - (c) Whether the position of a senior director is equal to the position of a chief officer?
 - (d) If (c) above is in negative then why were the so called senior directors appointed?

The Statement was committed to the Committee on Labour and Public Service (Statement No. 88)

5. Comprehensive statement sought on 24th January, 2017 by Hon. Robert Serbai from chairperson committee on Administration, peace Justice and Legal Affairs concerning the role of the county administrators. In the statement, the Chairperson should indicate;-

- a) Whether he is aware that the said administrators are currently recruiting members to *Chama Cha Mashinani (CCM)* and advocating for policies of the same party?
- b) Who instructs the said officers to recruit members to CCM party?
- c) What disciplinary measures has the County executive taken given that the said administrators are public officers and have therefore breached the provisions of section 15 of the Public Officers Ethics Act?

{The statement had initially been committed to the Committee Labour and Public Service but on 8th February, 2017 it was directed that it be handled by the committee on Administration, peace Justice and Legal Affairs. The committee was given 7 days to report to Assembly} - (Statement No. 94)

6. Statement sought Hon. Leonard Kirui on 18th January, 2017 from the Chairperson Committee on Labour and Public Service concerning the current over-employment in the County Public Service. In the Statement, the Chairperson should indicate;
- (i) The Current wage bill in Bomet County Executive ;(The Committee should invite the CEC finance to shed light on the level of compliance with the Court ruling on Court Case N0.73 of 2016 **Kenneth Kiprotich & Other V the Governor Bomet County & others**). Section 25 of the Public Finance Management Regulations sets County expenditure on wages at 35% of County public revenue.
 - (ii) The number of employees that have been employed in Bomet County executive from the Year 2013 to date ;(The Committee should invite the County secretary Mr. Jonathan Soi, the acting County Secretary and the Director Human Resource to shed light on this issue)
 - (iii) The number of employees that have passed through the County Public Service Board since the Year 2013 to date.

The Statement was committed to the Committee on Labour and Public Service (Statement No. 90)

7. Statement sought by Hon. Samson Towett on 18th January, 2017 from the Chairperson Committee on Administration, Peace, Justice and Legal Affairs concerning the conversion of the former Agricultural Training Centre (ATC) to the Centre for Devolved Governance (CDG). In the Statement, the Chairperson should indicate;
- (a) How was the training centre converted i.e. was there an executive committee resolution?
 - (b) Which department does the CDG falls into and which budgetary line is it being financed?
 - (c) How many officers have been deployed to CDG and in what positions are they holding?
 - (d) Whether the Centre is a dumping site for otherwise redundant or “unwanted” staff?
