QUESTIONS AND STATEMENTS

Responses to the following questions are due;

1. Question asked by Hon. Lily Cherotich concerning PWDS in the County. In reply, the chairperson (Committee on Gender, Culture and Social Service) should state:
 - a) Whether the relevant County Executive Department is aware that the access road leading to County Department of Gender, Culture and Social Services is impassable for persons with disabilities?
 - b) What steps has the County Government of Bomet taken to ensure that public and private places are accessible for Persons with Disabilities?

[Response was issued on 2nd May, 2023 at 2.20 p.m. and Hon. Deputy Speaker noted that the response was not satisfactory and directed the Chairperson to give a comprehensive response within two weeks].

2. Question by Hon. Eric Kirui raised on 15th February, 2023 concerning dodder weed in Kimulot Ward. The Hon. Member sought to know whether the Department of Agriculture, Livestock and Fisheries;
 - i. Is aware of the existence of dodder weed in Kimulot Ward
 - ii. Is aware of the current sporadic spread of the weed in the county
 - iii. Has noted the potential threat that the weed is likely to pose to the tea-growing farmers who largely depend on tea for daily subsistence
 - iv. Has noted the grievous harm the weed might cause to the county if not acted upon
 - v. There are mitigating factors that the department has put in place to curb the further spread of the weed in the county
