3. Whether the board of management of the hospital approved the said construction.
4. The procedure used to award the tender to the contractor.
5. The contractor awarded the tender of the said construction.
6. Whether the said project was in the budget approved by the Assembly.
7. The cost of the construction and the amount spent to date.

I would wish to get the answer within minimum time possible. Thank you.
