1. Statement sought by Hon. Leonard Kirui on 17th May, 2016 from the chairperson Committee on Education, Youth and Sports concerning the allocation of bursary to needy students in day schools in Siongiroi ward. The Hon. Member wished to be informed on why the students failed to receive Ksh 7,500 each during the 2014/15 and 2015/16 financial years yet there were budgetary allocations of Ksh. 70,000,000 under 26404402 and 20,000,000 under vote 26401101 respectively and a policy to that effect

Committed to the Committee on Education, Youth and Sports (Statement No. 48)

2. Statement sought by Hon. Robert Serbai on 6th July, 2016 from the Chairperson Committee on Energy, Environment, Water and Natural Resources regarding Taboino and Cheptalal water projects.

In the Statement, the Chairperson should state;

1. How much Money was allocated to each of the projects;
2. How much has been spent on each of the projects;
3. The current status of the projects and how many residents will each of them serve when completed?
