STATEMENTS DUE ON 11th APRIL, 2017 AT 9.00 A.M

1. Comprehensive statement sought by Hon. Leonard Kirui on 30th August, 2016 from chairperson, committee on Labour and Public service on the fate of ECD assistants employed by the County Government. In particular, the chairperson should inform on the following;
 - a. Why the ECD assistants (recruited) have not received confirmation letters yet they have passed through the required employment procedures?
 - b. What is the department's plan towards the issuance of confirmation letters?

2. Statement sought by Hon. Hellen Chepkirui on 1st March, 2017 from the Chairperson, Gender, Sports and Social services Committee regarding allocations of funds for Persons With Disabilities. In the statement, the Chairperson should state;
 - a. The amount of money allocated to the persons with Disabilities during the 2016/2017 Financial Year and the amount which has already been used and the purpose for which it has been utilized.
 - b. The various programs undertaken to assist persons with different disabilities i.e with severe disabilities and non-severe disabilities

3. Statement sought by Hon. John Ngetich on 18th January, 2017 from the Chairperson Committee on Education, Youth & Sports concerning the newly constructed Sigor High School premises situated in Sigor Ward.

- ii. The status of completion;
- iii. The total cost of the project;
- iv. The amount of funds used to date ;
- v. Whether there was a prior agreement between the County and National government on the financing of the project since construction of secondary schools is a National government function according to schedule four of the constitution;
- vi. To what extent has Moi University been involved in the funding of the new Sigor high school premises owing to the main reason for re-allocation being to create room for setting up of Bomet University?

- vii. Who is the contractor awarded to implement the project (provide a copy of the contract)

4. Comprehensive statement sought by Hon. Samson Towett from the Chairperson, committee on Budget and Appropriation on the following;
- How much does the county expect as revenue from tea cess for F.Y 2016/17?
 - Was the tea cess revenue factored in the budget for F.Y. 2016/17?
 - Provide a list of roads to be constructed/maintained or the ones already constructed/maintained from tea cess revenue in the F.Y. 2016/17
