STATEMENTS DUE ON 15th MARCH, 2017 AT 2.30 P. M

1. Statement sought by Hon. John Molel on 7th December, 2016 from the Chairperson, Budget and Appropriation Committee on renovation of Governor's private residence using public funds. In Particular, the Hon. Members wished to be informed on the following;
 - b. How much was used to do the said renovation and were the payments done?
 - c. What sort of renovations were undertaken in the said private home?
 - d. Who was the contractor awarded the said contract and when were the renovations done?
 - e. Where are the minutes of the tender committee that sat to deliberate on the same?
 - f. What are the status of the pending cases and who has been charged?

The Statement was committed to the Committee on Budget and Appropriation (Statement No. 84)

2. Comprehensive sought by Hon. Wilson Keter on 21st February, 2017 statement from the Chairperson Committee on Water, Energy, Environment and Natural Resources on the desilting of water dams within the county. In particular he sought to get clarification on the following;
 - i. Whether the department is aware about a myriad challenges and suffering facing (PWD) persons with Disabilities as a result of silted dams
 - ii. How many water dams have been desilted within Kipsonoi Ward?

The Statement was committed to the Committee on Water, Energy, Environment and Natural Resources (Statement No. 97)

3. Comprehensive statement sought by Hon. Samson Towett on 22nd June, 2016 from the Chairperson, Committee on Infrastructure (Roads, Transport and Public works) on motor vehicles procured by the County Executive. He recently noted that several Isuzu D-max double cabin motor vehicles, tractors, water boozers, lorries, truck cranes were acquired by the executive arm of county government.

In the statement, the chairperson should explain the following:

- a. How many in number, for each category, type and cost of the stated motor vehicles and machines were acquired in the FY 2015/16?
- b. What is the identity of the supplier and nature of agreement (Payment on delivery or Hire purchase)?
- c. How much revenues on average are being collected monthly by water boozers and whether they being declared as Appropriation in Aid (A.I.A)?
- d. In the adopted Budget and Appropriation committee report, the CEC member for Finance stated as follows;

“Purchase of motor vehicles: was allocated the amount to allow for payment of the vehicles already purchased. The vehicles are being paid for instalments which will spill over to the FY 2016/2017”

From the above CEC statement, the Hon. Member need the following explanations;

- i. The number of motor vehicles purchased through via hire purchase agreement in the FY 2015/16,
- ii. The name of the supplier and the total amount spent on motor vehicles in the FY 2015/16
- iii. Make and model of the motor vehicles purchased in the FY 2015/16

The statement had initially been committed to the Committee on Infrastructure (Roads, Transport and Public works) **but on 15th February, 2017 at 2.30 p.m, the statement was formally referred to Budget and Appropriation Committee which was then given 14 days to respond to the issues. (Statement No. 58)**

4. Comprehensive statement sought by Hon. Leonard Kirui on 30th August, 2016 from chairperson, committee on Labour and Public service on the fate of ECD assistants employed by the County Government. In particular, the chairperson should inform on the following;

- a. Why the ECD assistants (recruited) have not received confirmation letters yet they have passed through the required employment procedures?
- b. What is the department's plan towards the issuance of confirmation letters?

The Statement was committed to the Committee on Labour and Public service (Statement No. 70)

5. Statement sought by Hon. Samson Towett on 18th January, 2017 from the Chairperson Committee on Administration, Peace, Justice and Legal Affairs concerning the conversion of the former Agricultural Training Centre (ATC) to the Centre for Devolved Governance (CDG).

In the Statement, the Chairperson should indicate;

- (a) How was the training centre converted i.e. was there an executive committee resolution?
- (b) Which department does the CDG falls into and which budgetary line is it being financed?
- (c) How many officers have been deployed to CDG and in what positions are they holding?
- (d) Whether the Centre is a dumping site for otherwise redundant or "unwanted" staff?

The Statement was committed to the Committee on Administration, Peace, Justice and Legal affairs (Statement No. 87)

6. Statement sought Hon. John Molel on 18th January, 2017 from the Chairperson Committee on implementation on the implementation status of Part IV of the Bomet County Co-ordination of Government Functions Act, 2014 on the appointment of Sub-county, ward, Area and Community administrators;

In the statement, the Chairperson should indicate;

- (a) Whether he is aware that additional administrators have been employed in addition to those which were previously advertised?
- (b) Whether he is aware that the County executive constantly keeps on creating more Area administrative units?
- (c) How many Sub-county, Ward, Area and Community administrators have been employed in Bomet County since 2013 to date?
- (d) How much is the current wage bill for the administrators?

The Statement was committed to the Committee on implementation (Statement No. 89)

7. Comprehensive statement sought on 24th January, 2017 by Hon. Robert Serbai from chairperson committee on Administration, peace Justice and Legal Affairs concerning the role of the county administrators. In the statement, the Chairperson should indicate;-

- a) Whether he is aware that the said administrators are currently recruiting members to *Chama Cha Mashinani (CCM)* and advocating for policies of the same party?
- b) Who instructs the said officers to recruit members to CCM party?
- c) What disciplinary measures has the County executive taken given that the said administrators are public officers and have therefore breached the provisions of section 15 of the Public Officers Ethics Act?

{The statement had initially been committed to the Committee Labour and Public Service but on 8th February, 2017 it was directed that it be handled by the committee on Administration, peace Justice and Legal Affairs. The committee was given 7 days to report to Assembly) - (Statement No. 94)}

8. Statement sought by Hon. Hellen Chepkirui on 1st March, 2017 from the Chairperson, Gender, Sports and Social services Committee regarding allocations of funds for Persons With Disabilities. In the statement, the Chairperson should state;

- a. The amount of money allocated to the persons with Disabilities during the 2016/2017 Financial Year and the amount which has already been used and the purpose for which it has been utilized.
- b. The various programs undertaken to assist persons with different disabilities i.e with severe disabilities and non-severe disabilities

The Statement was committed to the Committee on Gender, Sports and Social services (Statement No. 98)

- 1. Statement sought by Hon. Hellen Chepkirui on 1st March, 2017 from the Chairperson, Labour and Public services Committee regarding the number of Persons With Disabilities who have been employed in the County Public Service since inception of the County. In the statement , the chairperson should state:-

- a. The policy which the county government is using to ensure the progressive implementation of the principle that at least 5% of the members of the public in elective and appointive bodies are persons with disabilities
- b. The number of persons with disabilities who have been employed in each department of the county executive including the county executive committee.
- c. The numbers of persons with disabilities who have been employed as Early Childhood Education and Development assistants since this was a major recruitment in the County

The Statement was committed to the Committee on Labour and Public services (Statement No. 99)
