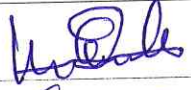
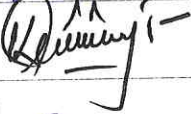
1.4 Committee meetings on vetting

2.0 Nomination of the Chief Officer for Administration

2.1 Legal Framework on for Appointment

Mr. Speaker Sir,

The Committee on Administration, Peace, Justice and Legal Affairs is one of the Sectoral committee established under standing order No. 193(1) and deals with all matters related to the department of administration including appointments that require the Assembly's approval including the appointment of the Chief Officers. Section 45 of the **County Governments Act** establishes the office of the Chief Officer. The said section requires the Governor to nominate and with the approval of the County Assembly, appoint the Chief Officer.

Further, Section 45 (2) of the **County Governments Act** provides that the Chief Officer-

- a) shall be competitively sourced from amongst persons who are university graduates with not less than ten years' experience in administration and management;
- b) shall be nominated from persons competitively sourced under paragraph (a) by the governor and, with the approval of the county assembly, appointed by the governor; and
- c) May, subject to the conditions and terms of appointment, be dismissed by the governor.

Additionally, Section 45(6) provides that a chief officer may resign from office by giving notice, in writing, to the governor.

The procedure for approval hearing, issues for consideration and period for consideration and reporting is provided for under the **Public Appointments (County Assemblies Approval) Act, No. 5 of 2017.**

Article 73 (2) of the Constitution on leadership and Integrity provides as follows:

That the guiding principles of leadership and integrity include;

- a) Selection on the basis of personal integrity, competence and suitability in free and fair elections;
- b) Objectivity and impartiality in decision making and in ensuring that decisions are not influenced by nepotism, favoritism, other improper

motives or corrupt practices.

- c) Selfless services based solely on the public interest, demonstrated by-
 - i. honesty in the execution of public duties
 - ii. The declaration of any personal interest that may conflict with public duties.
 - iii. Accountability to the public for decisions and actions; and
 - iv. Discipline and commitment in service to the people.

2.2 Issues for consideration in conducting the Approval hearing

In conducting the Approval hearing, the Committee was guided by **Article 73 (2) (a) (b) (c) and (e) of the Constitution, Section 7(8) and Section 8 of the Public Appointments (County Assemblies Approval) Act, No. 5 of 2017**

2.3 Circumstances for nomination of the Chief Officer for Administration.

Pursuant to Article 179 (b) of the Constitution and the provisions of section 45 of the County Government Act, 2012, H.E. the Governor, vide a letter dated **11th July, 2018** forwarded to the Clerk of the County Assembly a nominee by the name Mr. David Kipyegon Cheruiyot for vetting and approval.

2.4 Notification to the nominee

On Friday 12th July, 2018, the Clerk of the Assembly, pursuant to Section 7(4) of the **Public Appointments (County Assemblies Approval) Act, No. 5 of 2017** notified the nominee of the time and place for holding the approval hearing through an advertisement in the main print media.

2.5 Notification to the Public

Mr. Speaker Sir,

The public was expected to participate in the vetting process through submission of memoranda (affidavit) on the suitability of the nominee. On Friday 12th July, 2018, pursuant to section 7(4) of the Public Appointments (County Assemblies Approval) Act, the Clerk of the County Assembly placed an advertisement in the main print media and the Assembly website inviting the public to submit memoranda /information or petition that may have a bearing on the selection of the candidates by Friday 27th July, 2018 on the said nominee.

2.6 Submission of relevant documents from the nominee

The nominee submitted copies of the following documents: -

- i. ID Card/Passport
- ii. Compliance Certificate from Kenya Revenue Authority (KRA)
- iii. Clearance Certificate from Higher Education Loans Board (HELB)
- iv. Clearance Certificate from Ethics and Anti- Corruption Commission (EACC)
- v. Certificate of Good Conduct from the Criminal Investigation Department
- vi. Clearance from respective professional bodies
- vii. Clearance Certificate from Credit Reference Bureau (CRB)

2.7 Vetting Process of the Chief Officer for Administration

Mr. Speaker Sir,

This County Assembly can recall that, on 11th July 2018, the Hon. Speaker in his communication to the Assembly directed that the name and Curriculum Vitae of the said nominee be referred to the Committee on Administration, Peace, Justice and Legal Affairs for vetting and reporting to the County Assembly within 21 days.

Mr. Speaker Sir,

In conducting the vetting process, the committee examined the nominee against the following criteria, amongst others, in accordance with the Public Appointments (County Assemblies Approval) Act No.5 of 2017.

- i. Academic qualifications
- ii. Employment record
- iii. Professional affiliations
- iv. Potential conflict of interest
- v. Knowledge of the relevant field
- vi. Overall suitability for the position
- vii. Tax compliance
- viii. Integrity

On 30th July, 2018 the nominee appeared before the committee for vetting.

The nominee submitted originals/copies of the following documents: -

 - Kenya Certificate of Secondary Education
 - Kenya Certificate of Primary Education
3. Compliance Certificate from Kenya Revenue Authority (KRA)
4. Compliance certificate from Higher Education Loans Board (HELB)
5. Self-declaration form from the Ethics and Anti-Corruption Commission
6. Police clearance certificate
7. Clearance certificate from Credit Reference Bureau (CRB)

Mr. Speaker Sir,

I. Academic Qualifications

In regard to his academic qualifications, the committee noted that,

- In 1993-1998 the nominee graduated with Bachelor of Education Arts (Second Class Honours) from University of Kenyatta University.
- In 1988-1991 he joined Olbutyo Secondary School for Kenya Advanced Certificate of Education (KCSE).
- In 1980-1987, he attended Segemik Primary School where he sat and attained Kenya Certificate of Primary Education (KCPE).

II. Professional Qualification

He is a teacher and a current Deputy Principal of Kimaya Secondary School.

III. Professional Bodies

He is a registered teacher with the Kenya Teachers Service Commission

IV. Workshops

Re-evaluating the role of Deputy Principal in the 21st Century held between 12th - 15th June, 2016 by KUPPET and TSC.

V. Employment Record

In regard to his employment record, the committee noted that: -

He will make sure that the same is factored in the supplementary budget for it to get funding.

How he will handle a conflict of interest arising from a tender (a case study)

He will enforce good governance if his nomination is approved by the County Assembly hence will not aid any form of improper demeanor. Further, he will ensure that tenders are won competitively, fairly and without any undue influence. He will also discourage such vices as nepotism and corruption.

How he will deal with contractors protesting delayed payment of their dues by the county government

He will do an exhaustive inquiry into their grievances to check on their demerits and merits thereto. Where he finds the same to be candid, he will recommend payment of their dues.

He will also ensure that projects are captured in the budget so that such situations can be deterred. He will also ensure that an efficient and effective monitoring and evaluation system is in place so that only meriting works are paid.

On a case scenario where the County Assembly is anticipating passing a motion that only persons from Bomet get employment in the County

He would advise the county against such action as that will be contravening the Constitution and the same shall be null and void for all purpose. This is informed by the fact that chapter 2 of the Constitution set out national values which the intended motion negates.

On the issue of devolved units and the extend of devolution.

How he intends to deal with lack of policy framework

He will advise the county executive to ensure that such policies are formulated and forwarded to the County Assembly.

How he will handle orders from his seniors that may not be within the law or even above his mandate.

He will discharge his duties as a law abiding citizen objectively and without fear or favour as long as the same is within the law.

On the best idea which he has ever given and the used successfully.

He has given Servant leadership theory.

This will involve making public servants to provide service with humility.

- II. **Memoranda contesting the suitability of the Nominee:** There was no memorandum submitted to the committee challenging the nomination or otherwise of Mr. David Kipyegon Cheruiyot as the chief officer Administration
- III. **Integrity: Based on the following statutory documents and professional affiliations.**

- II. The County Assembly **APPROVES** the nomination for appointment of **Mr. David Kipyegon Cheruiyot as Chief Officer for Administration.**
