STATEMENTS DUE ON 23rd NOVEMBER, 2016 AT 2.30 P.M

1. Comprehensive Statement sought by Hon. Sammy Chelule on 6th July, 2016 from the Chairperson committee on Gender, Culture and Social Services concerning the irregular withdrawal of funds meant for support of the old age persons by third parties. This is in relation to complaints from the following residents of my ward;
 - a) Tapnyobi Sigira
 - b) Chemutai Tabletko Barbaret

The above residents have complained that their identification numbers together with their SIM cards have been used by the area Community Development Assistant (CDA) to withdraw monthly stipends;

In the statement, the Chairperson should explain;

- i. The measures the department has in place to curb this anomaly;
- ii. The disciplinary action that the department has meted on the perpetrators of this menace

2. Statement sought by Hon. Josphat Kirui on 25th October, 2016 from the Chairperson Committee on Labour and Public Service concerning the monthly NHIF deductions for County employees.

In the statement, the Chairperson should state;

- (a) Why the said deductions have not been remitted occasioning the County government to part with Kshs.2 Million to defray hospital expenses for Chief Officer Mrs. Baliach;
- (b) What measures are being undertaken by the County Government to address the issue given that the Vice-Chair of the County Public Service Board is due for treatment in India and has been turned down by NHIF citing non-remittance of monthly deductions?

3. Statement sought by Hon. Josphat Kirui on 25th October, 2016 from the Chairperson Committee on Roads, Transport and Public Works concerning the construction of the following roads in Ndaraweta Ward;
 - (a) Teganda Shopping Centre- Tea Zone-1.7 K.m
 - (b) Tea zone- Nyongores- 2.5 Km
 - (c) Kiptogoch road

(d) Mogoiywet-Kiptenden Road

In the statement, the Chairperson should state;

- (a) Whether he is aware that the said roads have not even been murramed despite the contrary information given in the implementation status report that the same have been completed;
- (b) The fate of the fuel levy fund which was supposed to be utilized in the repair of Sonokwek Road during the 2015/16 Financial Year yet the said funds have not been disbursed and the financial year has already lapsed.

- 4. Comprehensive statement sought on 3rd August, 2016 by Hon. John Chepkwony from the Chairperson Committee on Health and Sanitation concerning the stalled Labotiet Dispensary in Chebunyo Ward. In the statement, the Chairperson should;
 - a) Explain why the dispensary which was funded during the 2013/14 financial year has stalled for a long time
 - b) Indicate the amount of money that had been allocated to the project
 - c) State the time frame within which the project was supposed to be completed
 - d) Indicate the amount of money that has already been spent
 - e) Explain why the supplier of the said project has not been paid for the materials already supplied
 - f) Explain why the seller of the land where the dispensary has been constructed has not been paid for the land despite the issuance of A.I.E one year ago
 - g) Indicate how much money is still required until the completion of the project
 - h) Indicate when will Labotiet dispensary, a long stalled project be completed?

- 5. Statement sought by Hon. Robert Serbai on 6th July, 2016 from the Chairperson Committee on Energy, Environment, Water and Natural Resources regarding Taboino and Cheptalal water projects. In the Statement, the Chairperson should state;
 - i. How much Money was allocated to each of the projects;
 - ii. How much has been spent on each of the projects;
 - iii. The current status of the projects and how many residents will each of them serve when completed?
