THAT, Aware that pursuant to Article 42 of the constitution every person has a Constitutional right to a healthy and clean environment. Noting that the Constitution advocates for public participation in the management, protection and conservation of the environment; further appreciating that refuse removal, refuse dumps, solid waste disposal and forestry are devolved functions of the county governments and that every person has a role to play in realizing this; this County Assembly urges that the County Executive Member in charge of Water, Forestry, Environment and Natural Resources develops a County Policy that will set a day in every month for the public to participate in a green, clean and healthy environment exercise.

STATEMENTS DUE ON 14th FEBRUARY, 2017 AT 2.30 P.M

1. Comprehensive statement sought by Hon. Leonard Kirui on 30th August, 2016 from chairperson, committee on Labour and Public service on the fate of ECD assistants employed by the County Government. In particular, the chairperson should inform on the following;
 - a. Why the ECD assistants (recruited) have not received confirmation letters yet they have passed through the required employment procedures?
 - b. What is the department's plan towards the issuance of confirmation letters?

The Statement was committed to the Committee on Labour and Public service (Statement No. 70)

2. Comprehensive statement sought by Hon. Samson Towett on 22nd June, 2016 from the Chairperson, Committee on Infrastructure (Roads, Transport and Public works) on motor vehicles procured by the County Executive. I recently noted that several Isuzu D-max double cabin motor vehicles, tractors, water boozers, lorries, truck cranes were acquired by the executive arm of county government.

In the statement, the chairperson should explain the following:

- a. How many in number, for each category, type and cost of the stated motor vehicles and machines were acquired in the FY 2015/16?
- b. What is the identity of the supplier and nature of agreement (Payment on delivery or Hire purchase)?
- c. How much revenues on average are being collected monthly by water boozers and whether they being declared as Appropriation in Aid (A.I.A)?
- d. In the adopted Budget and Appropriation committee report, the CEC member for Finance stated as follows;

"Purchase of motor vehicles: was allocated the amount to allow for payment of the vehicles already purchased. The vehicles are being paid for in installments which will spill over to the FY 2016/2017"

From the above CEC statement, I need the following explanations;

- i. The number of motor vehicles purchased through via hire purchase agreement in the FY 2015/16,
- ii. The name of the supplier and the total amount spent on motor vehicles in the FY 2015/16
- iii. Make and model of the motor vehicles purchased in the FY 2015/16

The statement was committed to the Committee on Infrastructure (Roads, Transport and Public works) (Statement No. 58)

3. Comprehensive statement sought by Hon. Josphat Kirui on 23rd November, 2016 from the chairperson committee on Health and Sanitation. In particular he wished to be informed on;
 - a. The circumstances that led to the injury of the Governor Isaac Ruto and the steps the police have taken in investigating the matter that is an issue of public concern
 - b. The capacity of Longisa Hospital as a referral facility capable of doing surgery, the number of surgeons in the facility, their competencies, the medical equipment within the facility and whether they can handle number of patients in case of injuries and what steps the county government is undertaking to improve the facility
 - c. The steps the county Government of Bomet is undertaking to ensure that such an incident do not occur in future now that a political intolerance seems to be taking root

The Statement was committed to the Committee on Health and Sanitation (Statement No. 77)

4. Statement sought by Hon. Samson Towett on 18th January, 2017 from the Chairperson Committee on Roads, Transport and Public works on the remittance of ad valorem levy funds which were released to the County Government of Bomet on 20th July 2016 by the Tea Directorate of Kenya amounting to **KES 63,134,352**. The said funds were supposed to be remitted to respective factories based on their production figures for the development and maintenance of roads in tea growing areas.

In the statement, the Chairperson should indicate;

- i. Whether these funds have been released to the respective factories?
- ii. If not, then why has the County Executive not released these much needed funds to assist in the development of poor road network in these tea growing areas?
- iii. If (a) above is in the affirmative, then what system did the County executive employed in dispensing the funds to the factories and how much did each factory get?
- iv. Whether the funds were captured in the budget as this is an additional revenue to the County

The Statement was committed to the Committee on Roads, Transport and Public works (Statement No. 86)

5. Statement sought Hon. John Molel on 18th January, 2017 from the Chairperson Committee on implementation on the implementation status of Part IV of the Bomet County Co-ordination of Government Functions Act, 2014 on the appointment of Sub-county, ward, Area and Community administrators;

In the statement, the Chairperson should indicate;

- (a) Whether he is aware that additional administrators have been employed in addition to those which were previously advertised?
- (b) Whether he is aware that the County executive constantly keeps on creating more Area administrative units?
- (c) How many Sub-county, Ward, Area and Community administrators have been employed in Bomet County since 2013 to date?
- (d) How much is the current wage bill for the administrators?

The Statement was committed to the Committee on implementation (Statement No. 89)

6. Statement sought by Hon. John Ngetich on 18th January, 2017 from the Chairperson Committee on Education, Youth & Sports concerning the newly constructed Sigor High School premises situated in Sigor Ward.

In the Statement, the Chairperson should explain:-

- i. The Budget line used to fund the project;
- ii. The status of completion;
- iii. The total cost of the project;
- iv. The amount of funds used to date ;
- v. Whether there was a prior agreement between the County and National government on the financing of the project since construction of secondary schools is a National government function according to schedule four of the constitution;
- vi. To what extent has Moi University been involved in the funding of the new Sigor high school premises owing to the main reason for re-allocation being to create room for setting up of Bomet University?
- vii. Who is the contractor awarded to implement the project (provide a copy of the contract)

The Statement was committed to the Committee on Education, Youth & Sports (Statement No. 91)

7. Comprehensive statement sought by Hon. Josphat Kirui on 12th December, 2016 from the chairperson Committee on Health and sanitation on the precise number of health workers recently employed on contractual terms at the beginning of December, 2016. In particular the Hon. Member wished to be informed on;
- a. Employee's individual profession and the health facility that each was deployed
 - b. What informed the decision of the department to hire the said workers
 - c. Whether those who had been shortlisted by the County Public Service Board were considered for the contractual employment
 - d. Whether the said contractual staff were sourced through County Public Service Board
