8* MOTION (Hon. Leonard Kirui)

THAT, aware that one of the functions devolved under Part 2 of the fourth schedule of the Constitution of Kenya 2010 is that of county transport including County Roads; also aware that Section 23 of Bomet County Disaster and Emergency Management Act, 2014 provides for instances when County Disaster Management Fund shall be used, also aware that the various roads within the county have been affected by heavy rains; further aware that Kapmusa Bridge connecting Siongiroi Ward and Sigor Ward across Nyangores river was swept away by water due to heavy rains thus putting the lives of the residents in danger, further aware that the said Bridge serve pupils in the neighbouring schools as well as residents in the area; further aware that County Emergency Fund allocation was approved in the Budget of the Current Financial Year, this County Assembly urges the County Executive to construct a bridge through the County Emergency Fund to help residents of the two wards.

9. MOTION (Hon. Leonard Kirui)

THAT, aware that Article 43 of the Constitution of Kenya 2010 stipulates that every person has the right to the highest attainable standard of health which includes the right to health care services; further aware that one of the principles of devolution under article 174 of the constitution is that of provision of easily accessible services to the people; further aware that the function of county health services has been devolved pursuant to paragraph 2 of Part 2 of the Fourth Schedule of the Constitution of Kenya; deeply concerned that many residents within the Bomet County and particularly in Kamabwai Village within Siongiroi ward trek for long distances in order to access medical services; noting that basic health is one of the key pillars of a functioning county health system; this Assembly urges the County Government to establish more Dispensaries in the County.

10.* MOTION (Hon. Aurelia Chepkirui)

THAT aware that one of the functions devolved under Part 2 of the fourth schedule of the Constitution of Kenya 2010 is that of outdoor advertising, also aware that there is no legislation currently regulating outdoor advertising and signage in Bomet County; deeply concerned that lack of such legislation will make it difficult to regulate outdoor advertising and signage in our county; this County assembly urges the County Executive Committee to come up with an outdoor advertising and Signage Policy within three months to regulate such activities in our County.
