STATEMENTS DUE ON 6th DECEMBER, 2016 AT 2.30 P.M

1. Statement sought by Hon. Josphat Kirui on 25th October, 2016 from the Chairperson Committee on Roads, Transport and Public Works concerning the construction of the following roads in Ndaraweta Ward;

- (a) Teganda Shopping Centre- Tea Zone-1.7 K.m
- (b) Tea zone- Nyongores- 2.5 Km
- (c) Kiptogoch road
- (d) Mogoiywet-Kiptenden Road

In the statement, the Chairperson should state;

- (a) Whether he is aware that the said roads have not even been murramed despite the contrary information given in the implementation status report that the same have been completed;
- (b) The fate of the fuel levy fund which was supposed to be utilized in the repair of Sonokwek Road during the 2015/16 Financial Year yet the said funds have not been disbursed and the financial year has already lapsed.
