That aware that there exist the Managed Equipment Services project for the supply of medical equipment by the National government: also aware that the aim of the project is to support devolution of equitable, accessible, affordable and quality health care, the National Government equipped 2 hospitals in each County and 4 National Referral hospitals with outsourced specialized state-of-the-art medical equipment; further aware that the aim of the project is to provide Kenyans with excellent uninterrupted health services regardless of their location in the country; aware that two (2) county hospitals in every county were selected by respective county governments, and include Longisa hospital for upgrading to county referral hospital and Ndanai health centre for upgrading to sub-county referral hospital; aware that all the Governors from the 47 counties were expected to sign memorandum of Understanding pursuant to Article 187 of the Constitution of Kenya, 2010 with the national government on leasing of the medical equipment; aware that among the counties which declined to sign the MoU is Bomet this County Assembly resolves that H.E the Governor Bomet County Government to sign the MoU.

It is notified that the House Business Committee, at their last meeting, approved the following ***tentative*** business to appear in the Order Paper for Tuesday (morning), July 12, 2016:-

Motion (Hon. Julius Korir)

THAT, aware that waste management have been devolved under part two of the fourth schedule of the Constitution of Kenya; also aware that one of those functions include refuse removal, refuse dumps, solid waste disposal and control of air pollution; further aware that Article 42 of the Constitution of Kenya provides that every person has the right to a clean and healthy environment; aware that the town is polluted due to lack of collection of solid waste by the relevant department; also aware that solid waste can be used for land filling as there are a lot of man holes left un attended after mining of sand and rocks in the county; aware that Bomet County is endowed with a lot of quarries where mining of sand and rocks is being carried out leaving behind large and dangerous man holes that are a great risk to the residents and especially young children; this County Assembly urges the County Executive Committee to land fill the man holes with the solid waste.

It is notified that the House Business Committee, at their last meeting, approved the following ***tentative*** business to appear in the Order Paper for Wednesday (afternoon), July 13, 2016:-

Motion (Hon. Julius Korir)

THAT, aware one of the devolved functions is county public works and services including storm water management system in built up areas under part two of the fourth schedule of

the Constitution of Kenya 2010; further aware that Bomet county is endowed with several rivers; further aware that during rainy seasons the rivers burst their banks; also aware that during the dry seasons these rivers are dry leading to deficit of water for domestic and commercial use; this county assembly urges the county executive committee to initiate a long term project such as construction of dams as water reservoirs so as to curb water shortages during dry seasons.

STATEMENTS TO BE ISSUED

1. Statement sought by Hon. Stephen Changmorik on 15th June, 2016 on why the Deputy Governor has not been in his office for the past three weeks. The Hon. Member had been to his office several times but it has always been closed. The Hon. Member sought to know his whereabouts from the Committee on Administration, Peace, Justice and Legal Affairs.

The statement was committed to the Committee on Administration, Peace, Justice and Legal Affairs (No 52)

2. Comprehensive statement sought by Hon. Julius Korir on 22nd June, 2016 from the chairperson Labour and Public Service Committee concerning the office of the acting County Secretary. In the statement the Chairperson should indicate whether the acting County Secretary Mr. Kilelson Mutai meets the requirements provided under section 44(2) of the County Governments Act 2012 as required under section 64 of the County Governments Act 2012

The statement was committed to the Committee on Labour and Public Service (No. 53)

3. Statement by Hon. Leonard Kirui on 28th April, 2016 from the Chairperson Committee on Lands, Urban Planning and Housing concerning the constructed public toilet in Siongiroi Market centre.

Specifically, the Hon. Member wished to be informed on the following:-

- i. The total amount of Money which was used in the construction of the toilet?

- ii. The reason why the project has not been in operation regardless of the fact that the construction has been completed.
- iii. The plans which the department of Urban planning have put in place towards the opening of the toilet and;
- iv. How the project will be operated i.e whether it will be run by the County government or it will be leased out.

4. Statement sought by Hon. Leonard Kirui on 17th May, 2016 from the Chairperson, Committee on Urban Planning, Lands and Housing concerning installation of street lights in Siongiroi market. The Hon. Member wished to be informed on;
- (i) Whether he is aware that the street lights have not been installed in Siongiroi Market yet Ksh. 7,000,000 under vote 3111504 had been allocated during the 2013/14 financial year
 - (ii) Why the said street lights have not been installed yet there was a program to install street lights in the headquarters of each ward?

5. Comprehensive statement sought on 16th March, 2016 from the Chairperson Committee on Education, Youth and Sports concerning the construction of six Early Childhood Development (ECD) centres in Kimulot Ward during the 2014/2015 financial year. The said ECD centres had each been allocated Kenya Shillings 933,000. The Hon. Towett Samson wished to be specifically informed on the following;
- a) Why Kimulot, Kibitgoi, Chamalal and Kapsengere ECD centres was each given KSh.300, 000 instead of Ksh 933,000 and what happened to the balance of Ksh 633,000 for each of the ECD centre?
 - b) Why Beekab Areret and Saptet ECD centres were not awarded any money yet they were among the identified ECD centres in Kimulot Ward?

- c) Where is Ksh.933, 000 which was allocated to each of the two centres (Beekab Areret and Saptet ECD centres)?
- d) Whether the said funds for the six ECD centres were factored in the current financial year as commitments carried forward?

The statement had initially been committed to the Committee on Education, Youth and Sports. *On 22nd June, 2016, the response was not given. The Hon. Speaker Directed that the matter be taken up by the Committee on Implementation and a report be presented in the House within 2 weeks (No. 38)*

- 6. Comprehensive Statement sought by Hon. Leonard Kirui on 22nd June, 2016 from the Chairperson *committee on Labour and Public Service* concerning the County Human Resource Advisory Committee.

In the statement, the Chairperson should explain;

- (a) The role of the said committee in the recruitment process and where does it get its mandate?
- (b) Who are the members of this committee and when was it established?
- (c) How many people have they recruited, promoted and/or interdicted since it was established?
- (d) Whether the County Public Service Board is aware of the existence of the said committee?
- (e) And if yes, whether the said committee has been consulting the County Public Service Board in the performance of its functions.

On 6th July, 2016 at 9:00 a.m, a response was given by the Chairperson, Committee on Labour and Public Service. The Hon. Speaker informed the Assembly that further direction be given in the afternoon (06/07/2016) (Statement No. 54)
