Also to indicate the details including the date of resignation, designations, departments affected of the said employees and indicate the measures and steps the county government has taken to replace the said former employees. The following was the response by the County Secretary (CS).

- I. That the county government appointed some officers on acting capacity awaiting substantive appointments. After further consultation with the CS the committee was informed that Nicholas Kerich and Jackson Langat were appointed on acting capacity for the positions of Chief Officer Public Works and Chief Officer TETII respectively
- II. List of employees who have resigned to seek elective posts, including the resignation dates, designation and departments of the said employees is hereby attached.
