PREFACE

2.1 Background

An Annual Development Plan (ADP) is a document that outlines priority projects and programs for implementation in one financial year. The document is expected to guide in facilitating sustainable economic growth and to address development challenges facing the county. The ADP should guide the implementation of projects and programs from each county department as stipulated in the County Integrated Development Plan (CIDP). It operationalizes a County Integrated Development Plan (CIDP). The document is a basis of all budgeting needs for the county's development agenda.

It is expected that the passage and approval of Bomet County Annual Development Plan for the FY 2020/21 will facilitate distribution, exploitation and development of the county's resources. The CEC in charge of Economic Planning and Development submitted the plan to the County Assembly on 5th November 2019. The document was tabled on 6th November, 2019 and committed to the Committee on Finance, ICT and Economic Planning for consideration. The Committee was required to examine, take necessary action and present a report on the findings and recommendations for adoption by the Assembly in line with Article 185(4) of the Constitution.

2.2 Mandate of the Committee

The County Assembly Standing Orders 193 and the second schedule establishes Finance, ICT and Economic Planning to deal with subject area of all matters relating to the County Treasury, revenue

policies, county economic planning and development including statistics and Information, Communication Technology.

Furthermore standing order 193(5) states the functions of a Sectoral Committee as follows:-

- a) investigate, inquire into, and report on all matters relating to the mandate, management, activities, administration, operations and estimates of the assigned departments;
- b) study the program and policy objectives of departments and the effectiveness of the implementation;
- c) study and review all county legislation referred to it;
- d) study, assess and analyze the relative success of the departments as measured by the results obtained as compared with their stated objectives;
- e) investigate and inquire into all matters relating to the assigned departments as they may deem necessary, and as may be referred to them by the County Assembly;
- f) to vet and report on all appointments where the Constitution or any law requires the County Assembly to approve, except those under Standing Order 188(Committee on Appointments) ; and
- g) make reports and recommendations to the County Assembly as often as possible, including recommendation of proposed legislation

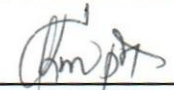
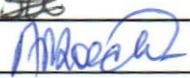
2.5 Public participation

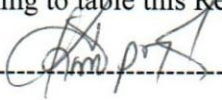

3 Legal Framework

Preparation of Annual Development Plan is anchored in law. Article 220 (2) of the Constitution states that;

National legislation shall prescribe—

- (a) *The structure of the development plans and budgets of Counties;*
- (b) *When the plans and budgets of the counties shall be tabled in the County Assemblies; and*
- (c) *The form and manner of consultation between the National Government and County Governments in the process of preparing plans and budgets*

Section 104 (1) of the County Governments Act states that;

“A County government shall plan for the county and no public funds shall be appropriated outside a planning framework developed by the County Executive Committee and approved by the County Assembly.”

Section 126 of the PFM Act, 2012 states as follows;- (1) Every County Government shall prepare a development plan in accordance with Article 220(2) of the Constitution, that includes—

- (a) *Strategic priorities for the medium term that reflect the county government's priorities and plans;*
- (b) *A description of how the county government is responding to changes in the financial and economic environment;*
- (c) *Programmes to be delivered with details for each programme of—*
 - (i) *The strategic priorities to which the programme will contribute;*
 - (ii) *The services or goods to be provided;*
 - (iii) *Measurable indicators of performance where feasible; and*
 - (iv) *The budget allocated to the programme;*
- (d) *Payments to be made on behalf of the County Government, including details of any grants, benefits and subsidies that are to be paid;*

(e) *A description of significant capital developments;*

(f) *a detailed description of proposals with respect to the development of physical, intellectual, human and other resources of the county, including measurable indicators where those are feasible;*

(g) *A summary budget in the format required by regulations; and*

(h) *Such other matters as may be required by the Constitution or this Act.*

(2) *The County Executive Committee member responsible for planning shall prepare the development plan in accordance with the format prescribed by regulations.*

(3) *The County Executive Committee member responsible for planning shall, not later than the 1st September in each year, submit the development plan to the county assembly for its approval, and send a copy to the Commission on Revenue Allocation and the National Treasury.*

(4) *The County Executive Committee member responsible for planning shall publish and publicize the annual development plan within seven days after its submission to the county assembly.*

4 Committee Findings and Observations

The committee reviewed the Annual Development Plan to establish whether the entire document was prepared in accordance with the law and relevant regulations. The committee also sought to ensure whether the plan contained the projects to be undertaken including the project's location. Subsequently, the committee, upon undertaking thorough scrutiny made its observations and findings as follows;

4.1 Summary: missing gaps and concerns noted.

The committee observed that;

- (a) That chapter two was erroneous particularly the department of Administration which indicated number of projects (ward offices) to have been completed yet they had never been started.
- (b) In chapter four, resource allocation was based on departmental requirements rather than the total estimated revenue. This resulted in raising the cost of implementing the listed projects and programs to over 11 Billion which is way too high.
- (c) Some departments did not indicate programs to be implemented i.e Roads and Education

4.2 Review of the Implementation of the previous Annual Development Plan 2018/2019

The committee made the following observations.

As compared to projects and programs that were planned for implementation in the period under review, most were below average except for roads, public works and Transport sector. Most of the departments did not absorb their development funds and this is a factor that partly contributed to re-allocation of funds in the subsequent budget.

4.3 County Assembly

The Assembly intends to undertake the construction of a mini chamber, and speaker's residence. These amounts to Ksh.300Million

1.1 Compliance level

The table below shows the committee assessment on the extent to which the County Annual Development Plan for 2020/21 has complied with the legal timelines and other provisions of the law.

A compliance rate of 59% is a slight drop from the previous year of 64%. It was noted that the department did not meet most of the issues highlighted in the previous ADP report. Public participation is a mandatory requirement in county planning as per section 115 1(a) of the County

Governments Act 2012. However, as indicated in the table, there was no evidence whatsoever in the document to show that public participation was carried out during the preparation of the annual development plan. The committee noted that, the County Integrated Development plan (CIDP) 2018-2022 had been previously subjected to public participation. And therefore, this Annual Development Plan (ADP) should have been subjected to the same process. To address the issue the committee however subjected the same ADP to a rigorous Public Participation process.

3.0 Issues and Responses from Departments

The committee identified several issues and sought clarifications from the relevant departments. This matter was addressed during a consultative meeting conducted in December 2018 in Nairobi. The same was considered under the Committee's recommendation.

4.0 Summary comments and views submitted by members of the public

Mr. Speaker Sir,

Public participation fora were held in all the 5 sub-counties of the county. The members of the public gave several views regarding to the ADP for the Financial Year 2019/2020. The specific concerns raised were mainly affected road infrastructure, educational infrastructure, the health facilities, bodaboda sheds, shoe shine sheds and access to water in the county. The members of the public acknowledged that implementation of projects and projects through the previous plans by the County Government can be witnessed.

4.4 General Comments

Mr. Speaker Sir,

Here is the summary of views and comments submitted by the members of the public on each of the county executive department.

4.5 Administration

Some of the members of the public were of the view that construction and completion of ward offices should be done in the respective wards.

4.6 Trade, Energy, Tourism and Industry

Majority of the members of the public proposed that Bodaboda sheds and shoe shiner sheds should be set up in each of the 25 wards.

4.7 Roads, Public Works and Transport

Majority of the members of the public were concerned about the quality of some of the roads which are being done in the County. They also suggested that all the roads constructions in future, should be monitored and the contractors should be required to deliver quality work.

4.8 Agri-Business and Cooperatives

It was the general view that extension services should be considered to enable farmers maximize on their returns in farming. It was further felt that this will assist in the dairy farming as well as crop farming and more so in the diversification of cash crops across all the wards.

4.9 Education and Vocational Training

It was generally agreed that more ECD centres should be constructed in all the wards. It was further suggested that support for the vocational Training Centres (VTCs) should be done equitably in all the wards to avoid skewed allocation of resources.

4.10 Medical Services and Public Health

Some of the members of the public were of the view that upgrading of some dispensaries to health centre status should be done equitably across the county.

4.11 Water and environment

It was noted that clean water supply across county is still a challenge. In light of this, it was generally agreed that water springs should be protected across the county. It was also suggested that desilting of water pans as well as establishing new ones should also be considered
