- 8. Motion - Establishment of a County Youth Hub and Resource Centre
(Hon. Leonard Ngeny)**

AWARE that Article 55(b) of the Constitution of Kenya, 2010 requires the State to take measures, including affirmative action programmes, to ensure that the youth have opportunities to associate, be represented and participate in political, social, economic and other spheres of life; **CONCERNED** that 60% of youths in the County were recorded to be unemployed as at the year 2019 Census Report, prior to emergence and spread of COVID-19, a situation that is expected to have worsen; **ACKNOWLEDGING** with appreciation existence the Access to Government Procurement Opportunities (**AGPO**) program both at the National and County Level which seeks to provide for a fair equitable, transparent and cost-effective public procurement of goods and services by ensuring 30% of Government Procurement is set aside for the enterprises owned by the Youth, Women and Persons with Disabilities and in line with the Public Procurement and Asset Disposal Act, 2015; **DISTURBED** that despite such measures by the Government to provide such opportunities to youth, many youth registered outfits are yet to benefit fully from the same due to lack of knowledge, late access to such information, lack of centralized and structured manner of disseminating information to the youth; **FURTHER**

DISTURBED that rare government call for application of opportunities such as internships, contractual works and other government assignments for the youths often records low uptake due to lack of an existing structure and communication hub and bureau for the youths in the County; this **ASSEMBLY URGES** the County Executive to establish, equip and staff a County Youth Hub and Resource Centre in each Sub-County that would see the Youth benefit on the following Services;-

- i) Link and dissemination of youth service and opportunities at the National and County Level;
- ii) Custody of youth Database at the County level;
- iii) Facilitate engagement of youth with the County Executive on implementation of National Policy; and,
- iv) Coordination of Public Participation and collections of views relating to youths

STATEMENTS

1. Comprehensive statement was sought by Hon. Weldon Kirui from the Chairperson Committee on Labour and Public Service regarding the office of the County Secretary. In the statement, the chairperson should respond on the following:
 - a) In the view of the recent judgment issued by the High Court of Kenya at Kisumu nullifying the appointment of Stella Chepkoech Langat as the County Secretary, I seek to be informed by the County Executive Committee Member for Administration, ICT and Public Service on what measures have been taken by the County Executive following her nullification of being the County Secretary?
 - b) Whether the County Government has initiated the process of recruiting the County Secretary
 - c) Who is the Acting County Secretary?
 - d) The County Assembly be furnished with a list of all the appointments and contracts executed by the former County Secretary Ms Stella Chepkoech Langat from the date of her appointment up to date for purposes of mitigating any potential legal challenges (*Statement sought by Hon. Weldon Kirui*)
