QUESTIONS AND STATEMENTS

The following questions and statements are due today Wednesday, 18th October 2023 at 9.30 a.m.

1. Hon. Catherine Chepngetich sought a comprehensive statement from the Chairperson **Committee on Trade, Tourism, and Cooperatives** on the status of the newly constructed market stalls within Bomet Town Market. In the statement, the committee should;
 - a) State the name of the contractor awarded the contract of construction of the said market stall, the cost of construction, the scope of works, and the timelines of the project;
 - b) State whether the construction of the market stalls was within the approved procurement plans and if so provide relevant documents to that effect.
 - c) State the reasons why accessibility of constructed market stalls by Persons with Disabilities (PWDs) was not taken into consideration.
 - d) State whether the construction of the said market stalls is complete and functional
2. The comprehensive statement sought by Hon. Richard Ruttoh on 21st September 2023 from the Chairperson Committee on Administration, Legal Affairs, and Citizen Engagement on the preparedness of the County Government in mitigating the effects of the anticipated El-Nino-induced climate extremes expected between the months of September and December 2023. In the statement, the committee should;
 - b) Highlight the cross-sectoral preparedness by the County Government in mitigating the adverse effects of the anticipated El-Nino rains to alleviate human suffering and prevent potential environmental degradation;
 - c) Outline measures and policies put in place on disaster intervention through capacity building for early warning and disaster preparedness and how the same is being applied to mitigate climate-related disasters;
 - d) State any substantial public sensitization that has been carried out on the impending impact of the anticipated El-Nino weather phenomenon, particularly on vulnerable populations; and
 - e) Ascertain whether the County Government in collaboration with National Government agencies has instituted cross-sectoral collaborative teams to manage any potential adverse effects of the anticipated El-Nino, considering past lessons.
