Aware that Article 183 of the Constitution of Kenya 2010 provides that the County Executive Committee shall provide the County Assembly with full and regular reports on matters relating to the county; further aware that section 166 of the Public Finance Management Act, 2012 requires that an accounting officer for a county government entity shall prepare a report for each quarter of the financial year in respect of the entity; also aware that the accounting officer shall ensure that the report contains information on the financial and non – financial performance of the entity; further aware that the quartet reports should be submitted to the County Assembly within one month after the end of each quarter; also aware that this County Assembly has not been receiving such periodic reports from the various departments of the County Government; this County Assembly urges the County Executive Committee from all the departments to submit the 2015/2016 F/Y expenditure reports to the County Assembly within a period of two months.
